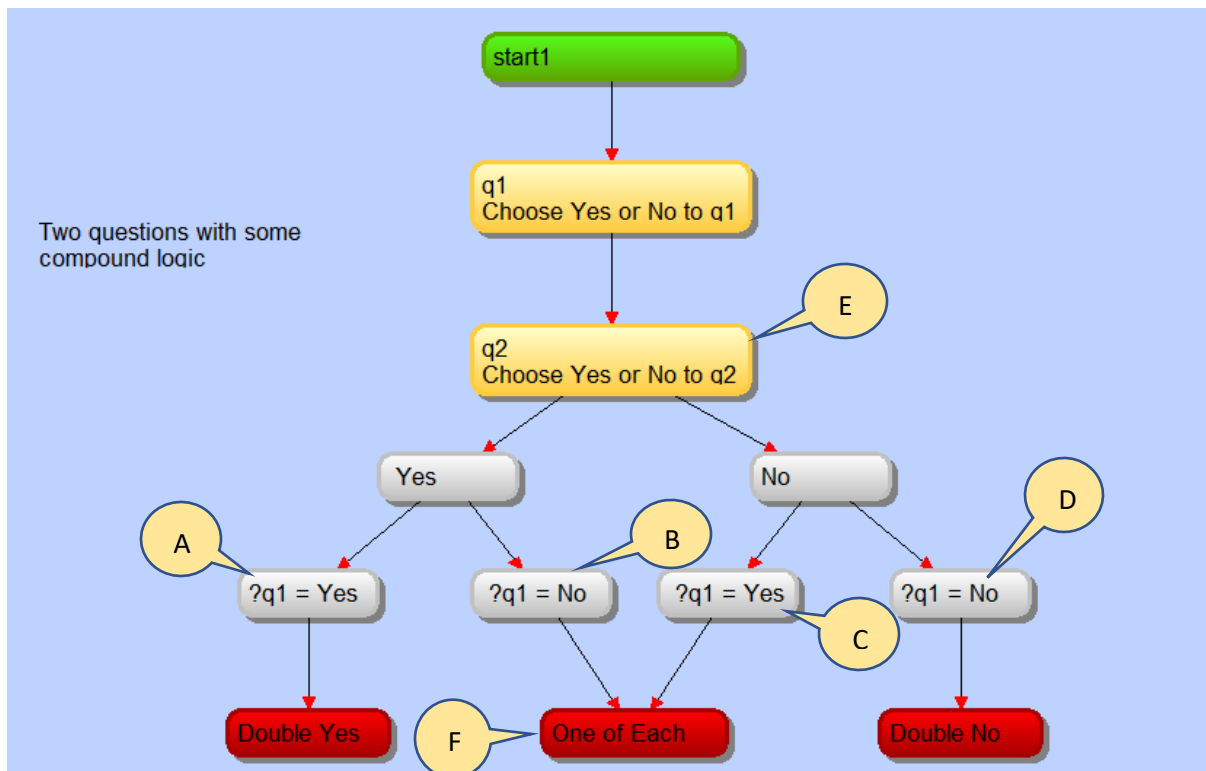


## Basic Structure



### Basic Structure example

- 2 single choice question
- 2+2+4 expressions
- 3 conclusions

This example shows how to use structured expressions and delayed referencing to combine answers to different questions. We ask the 2 questions 'up-front', and test their results in a different order.

#### A] expression

Refers back explicitly by name to answer to question q1

#### B] expression

Refers back explicitly by name to answer to question q1

#### C] expression

Refers back explicitly by name to answer to question q1

#### D] expression

Refers back explicitly by name to answer to question q1

#### E] single-choice question

Asked immediately after the first question

**F** conclusion

Two branches converge onto a single conclusion
